

GRANTS

The Diplomatic Security Foundation is pleased to demonstrate how your contributions have helped support those in the Diplomatic Security worldwide family during times of need. DSF donations are unrestricted gifts, requiring no re-payment. Anyone from the extended global DS "family" may be considered for a donation, per review by the DSF Board of Directors, which is composed of active, retired and former DS personnel.

2023 GRANTS: \$99,900

(as of 5/16/23)

\$12,000 to six DS employees at US Embassy Khartoum (Sudan) who recently evacuated on ordered departure. The military-assisted departure required the staff to fly out with only a backpack due to the rapidly deteriorating security situation and had to leave most of their personal items.

\$3,750 to a Marine Security Guard at US Embassy Vientiane (Laos) to assist with uninsured medical and funeral costs for his father who recently passed away.

\$1,500 to the family of a local guard at US Consulate Karachi (Pakistan). He had worked for the Consulate for 17 years. He leaves behind a wife and an 8-year-old daughter.

\$2,000 to the family of a local guard at US Embassy Havana (Cuba) who died suddenly of a brain aneurysm. He had been a member of the LGF for the past 4 years, but prior to that he had been a gardener for several embassy families. He was considered an outstanding employee by RSO. He died as he was leaving his home to go to work. He was single parent to his teenage son.

\$5,000 to a DS employee at FASTC to help with uninsured medical and funeral costs for his wife who recently passed away from cancer.

\$42,600 to 142 members of US Mission Turkey to help with the cost of temporary lodging, food, diapers, and winter clothing for those affected by the February 6, 2023 earthquakes.

\$3,800 to a member of the US Embassy Mexico City police force to assist with costs associated with spouse's illness and death from Covid.

\$5,000 to a former guard at US Embassy New Delhi (India) for medical costs associated with a recent health issue.

\$3,000 for a local guard at US Embassy Kuala Lumpur (Malaysia) for costs associated with spouse's illness and surgery.

\$6,000 to three local guards from US Embassy Eritrea (East Africa) to help with the relocation costs.

\$3,500 to a local guard at US Embassy Cairo (Egypt) to help with costs of a new prosthetic.

\$1,750 to the family of a guard from US Embassy Maseru (Lesotho) who was murdered.


The Golf Club at Lansdowne is a soft spike only facility. Please have your metal spikes changed prior to the shotgun start.
